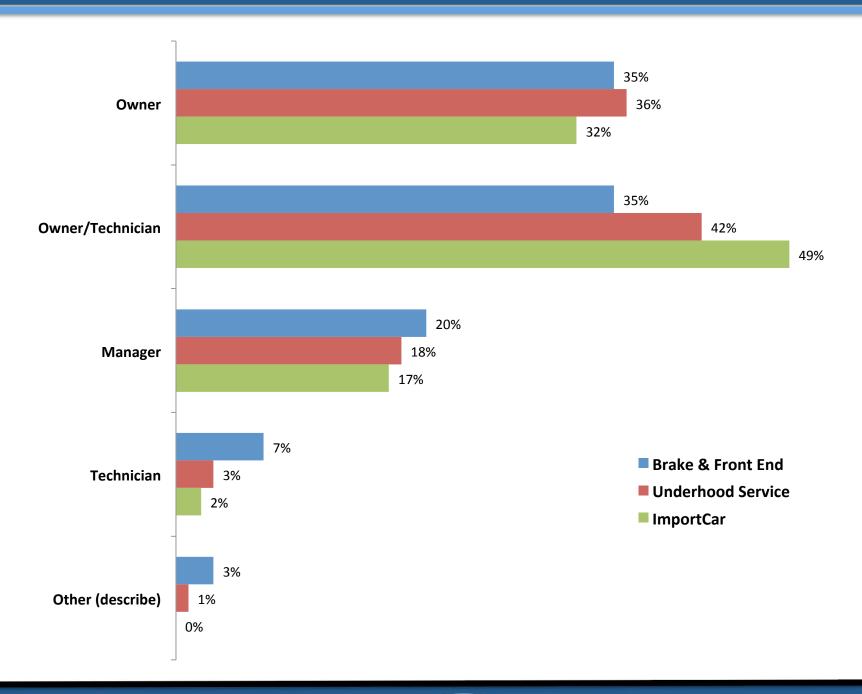

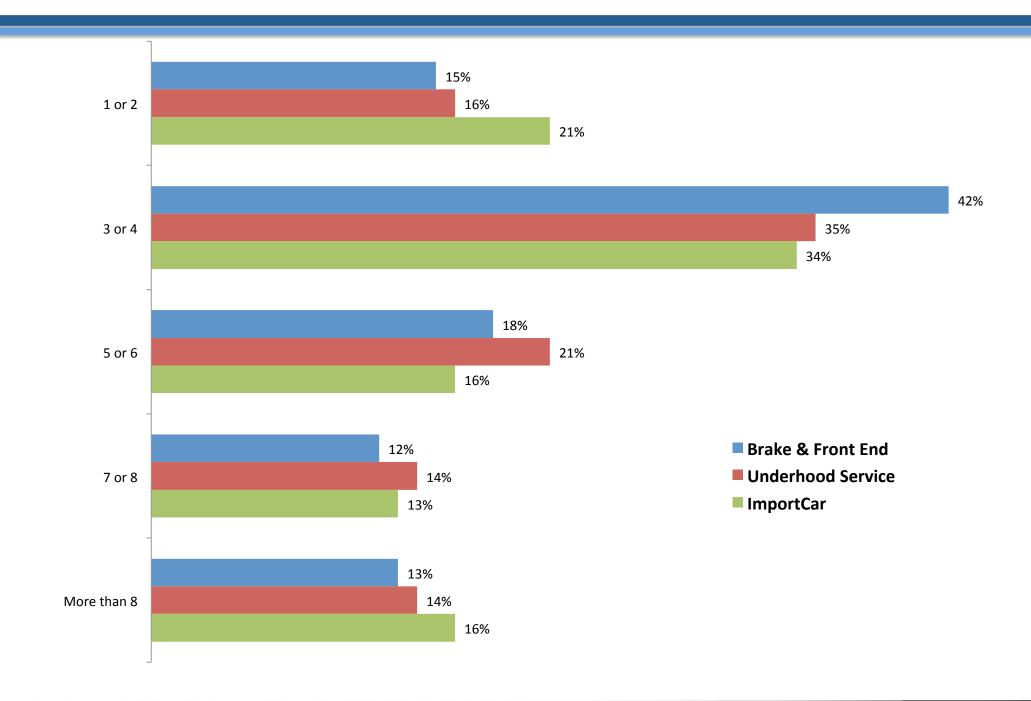

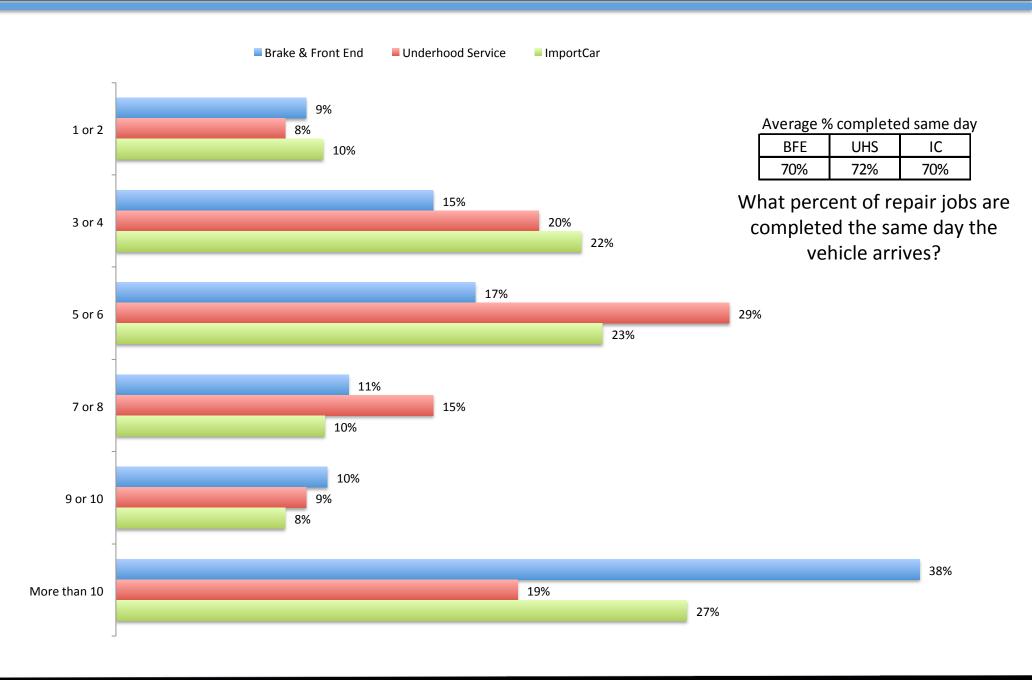


### How many service bays do you have at this location?





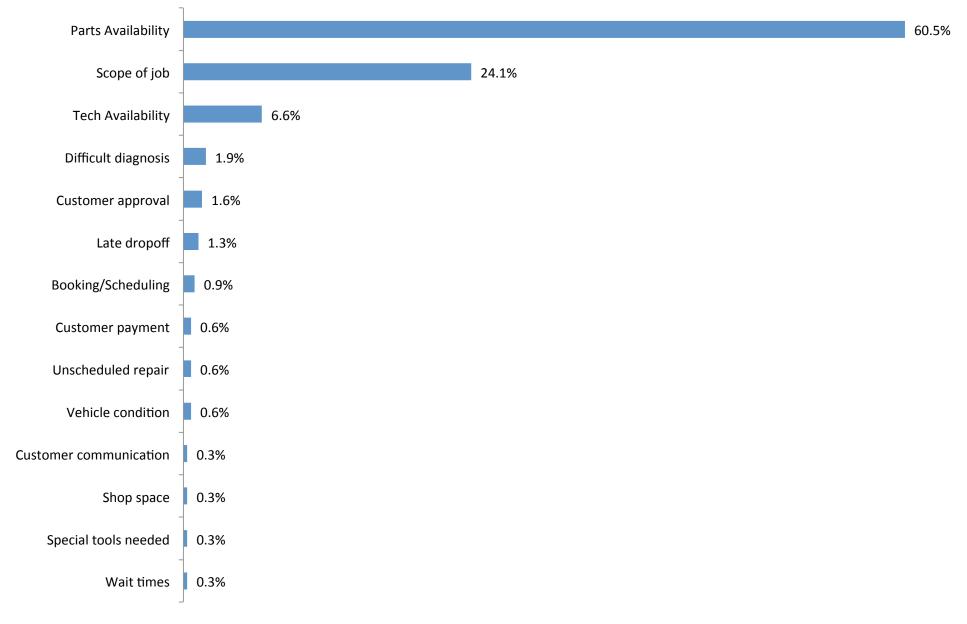
### What is your average daily car count?





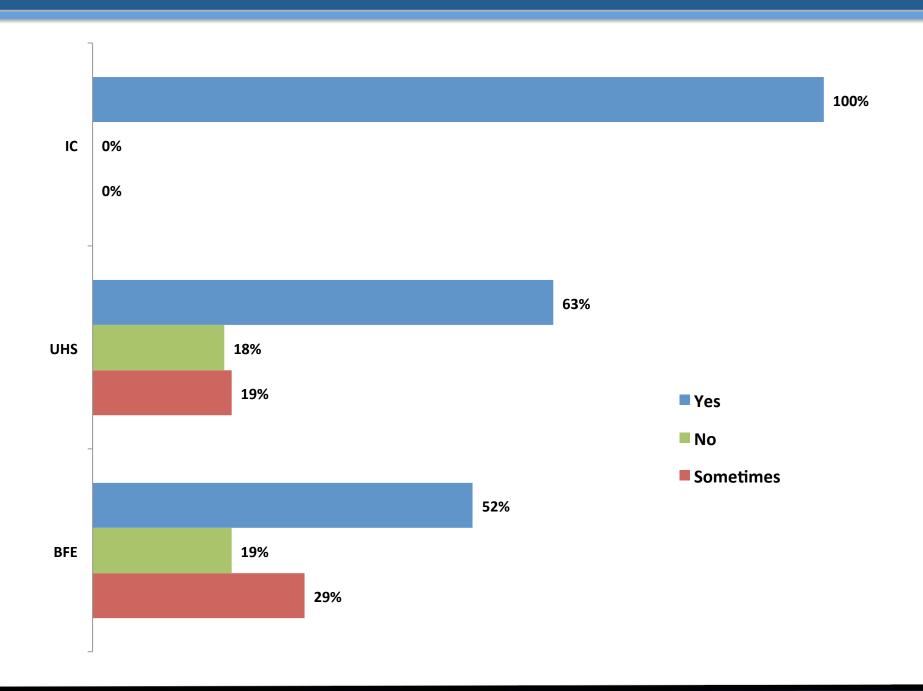

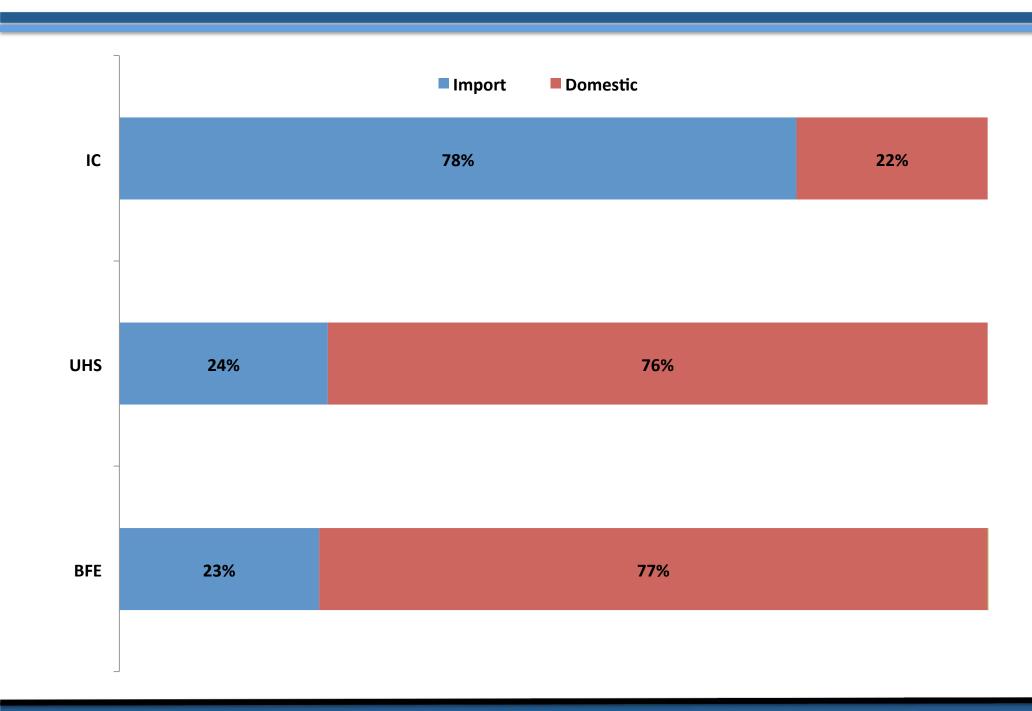




### Does your shop service import nameplates?

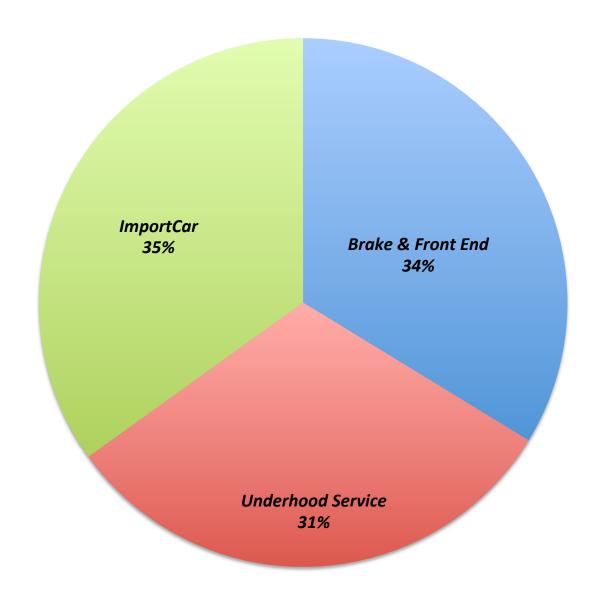


### What is the percentage of vehicles worked on in your shop?



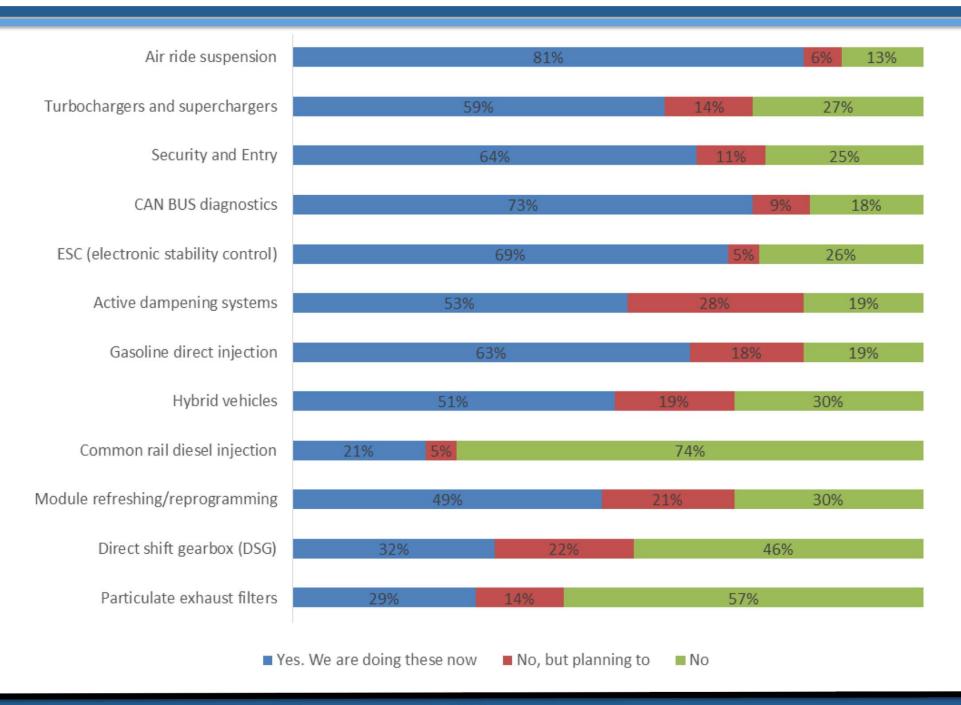


### Percentage with a designated service writer/sales person/front counter help



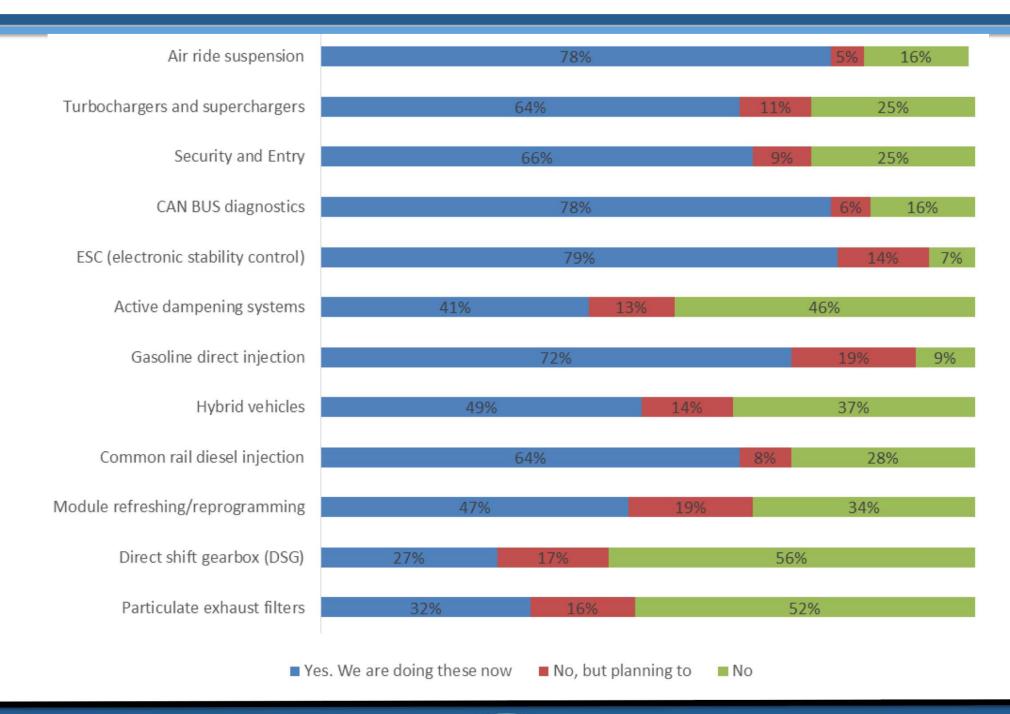

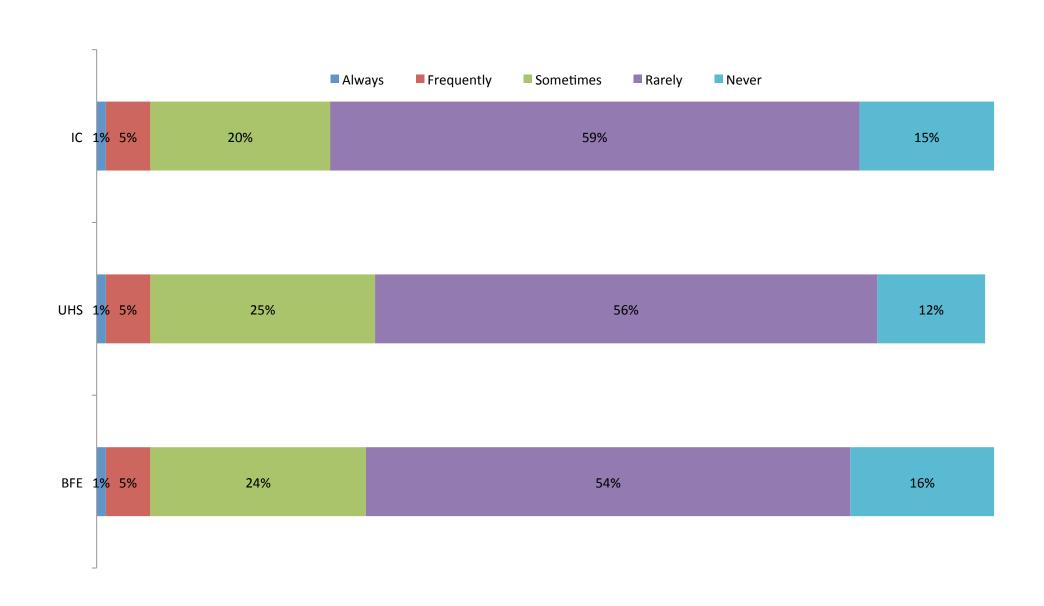


### If you do NOT service some or all of the emerging technologies, how do you deal with customers needing those repairs?



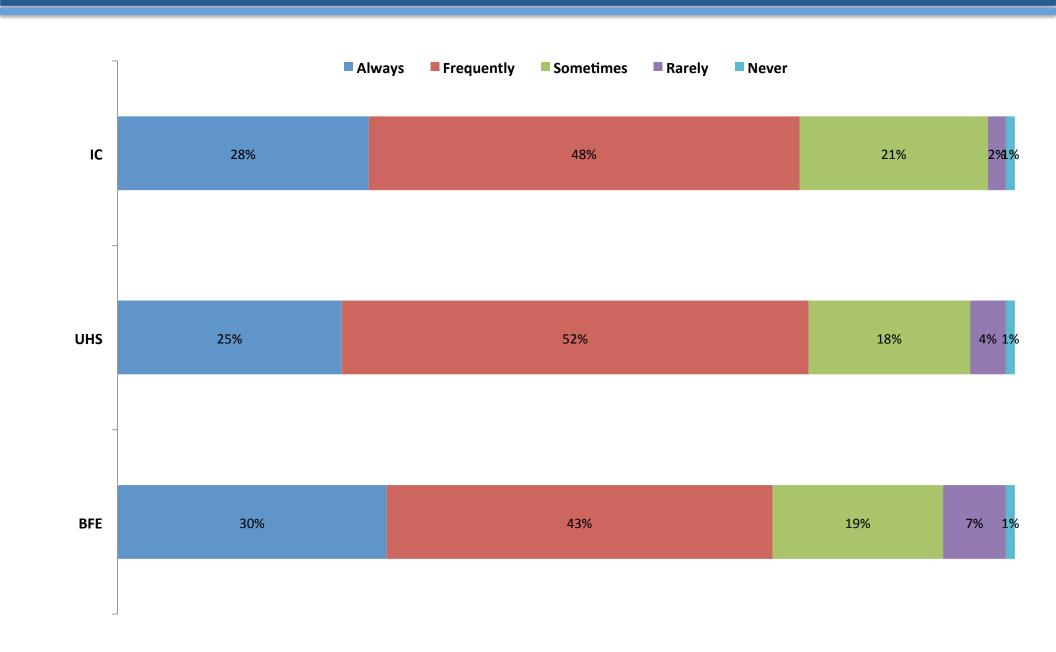


### How often do your customers specify a particular brand of replacement part for their vehicle?



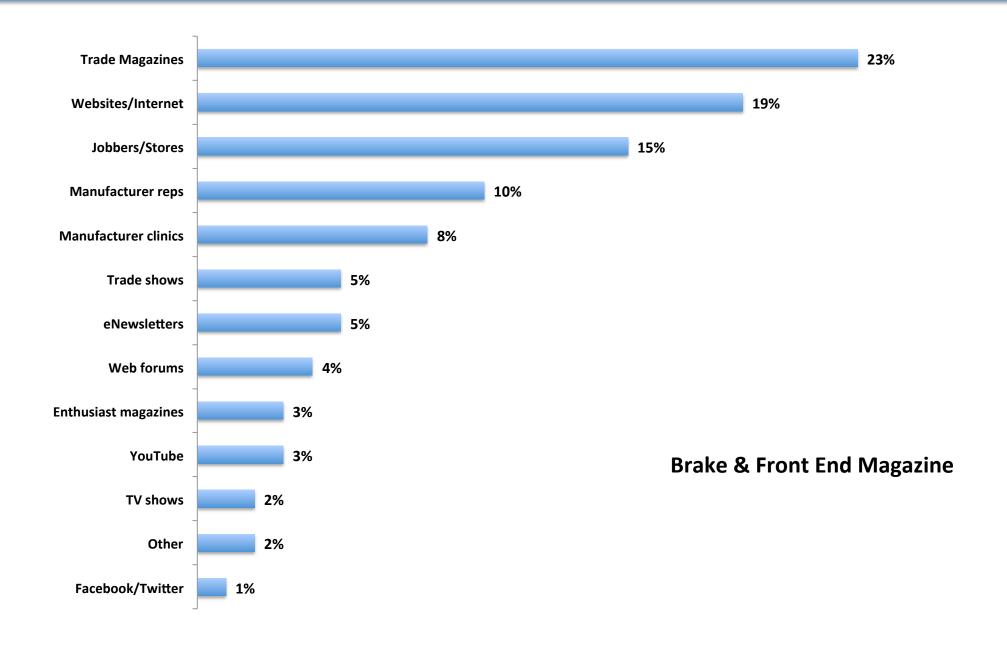

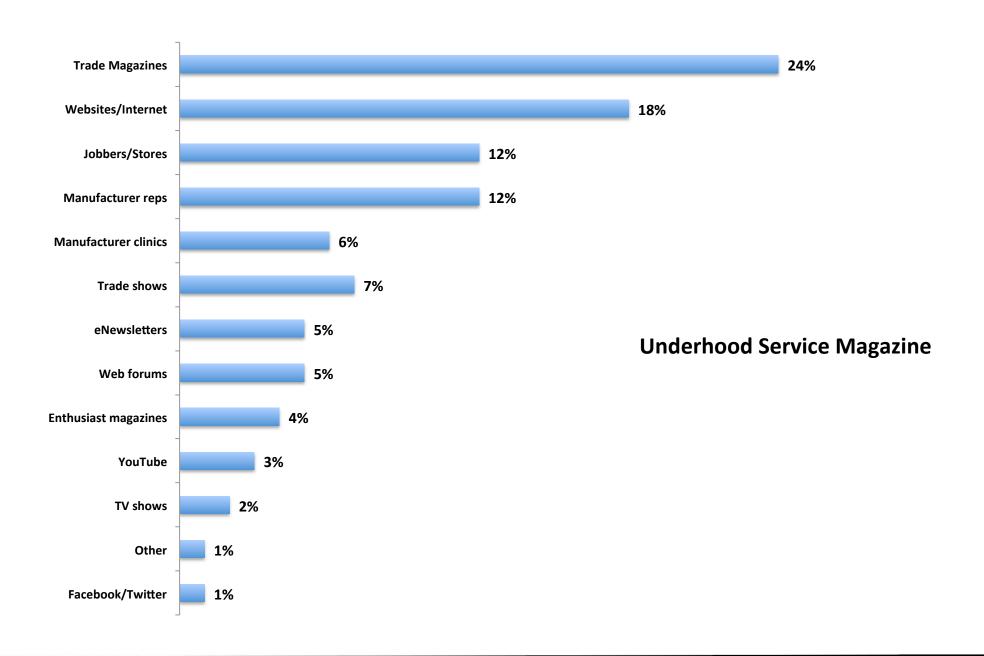


### From the list of sources below, which do you rely on to get the most information on new products?

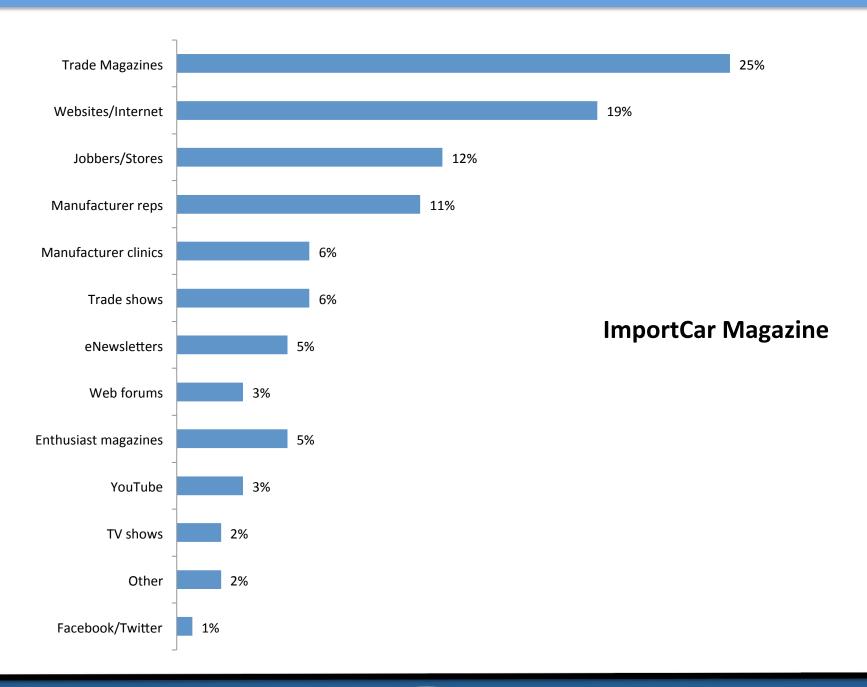

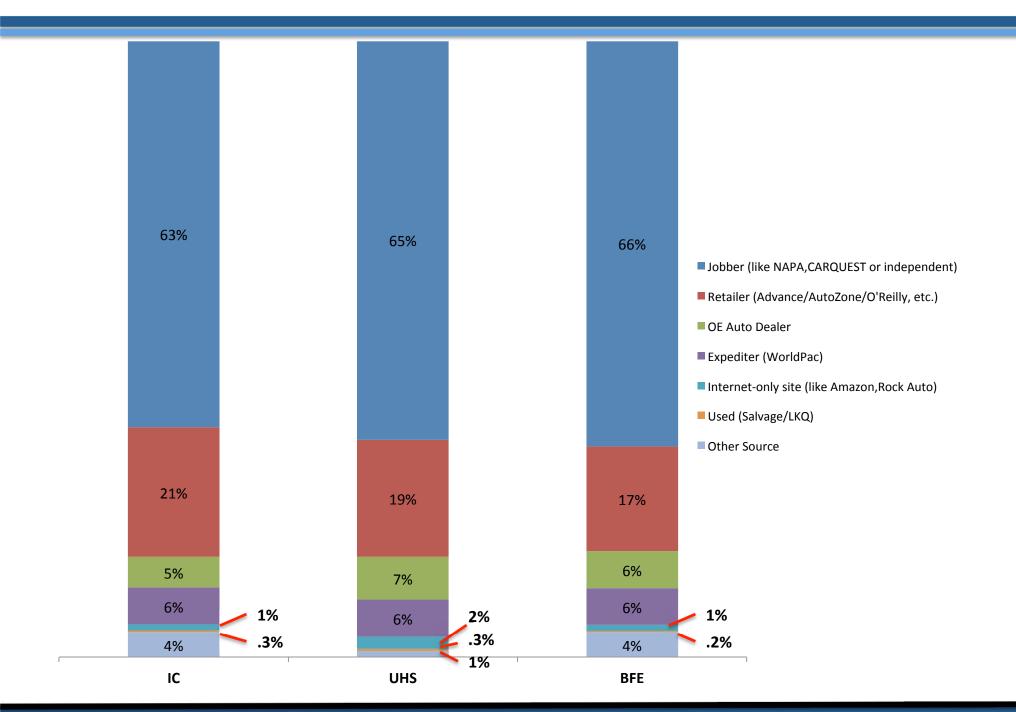

### Which is your primary source for parts?

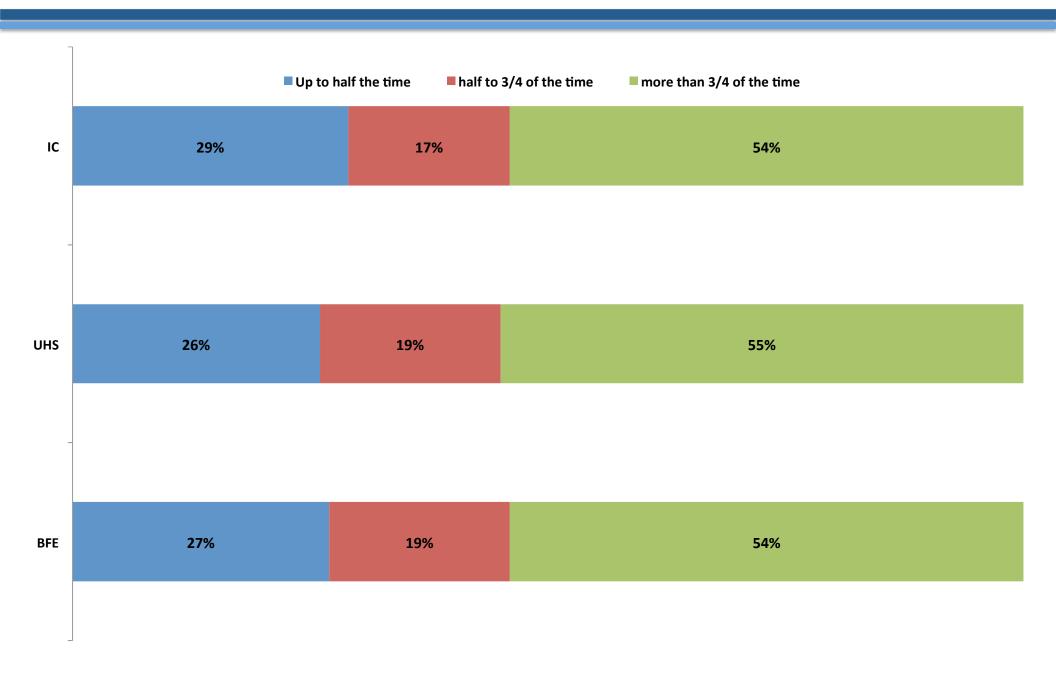




#### When you don't have the part in stock, how long does it take for your local parts source to deliver it?

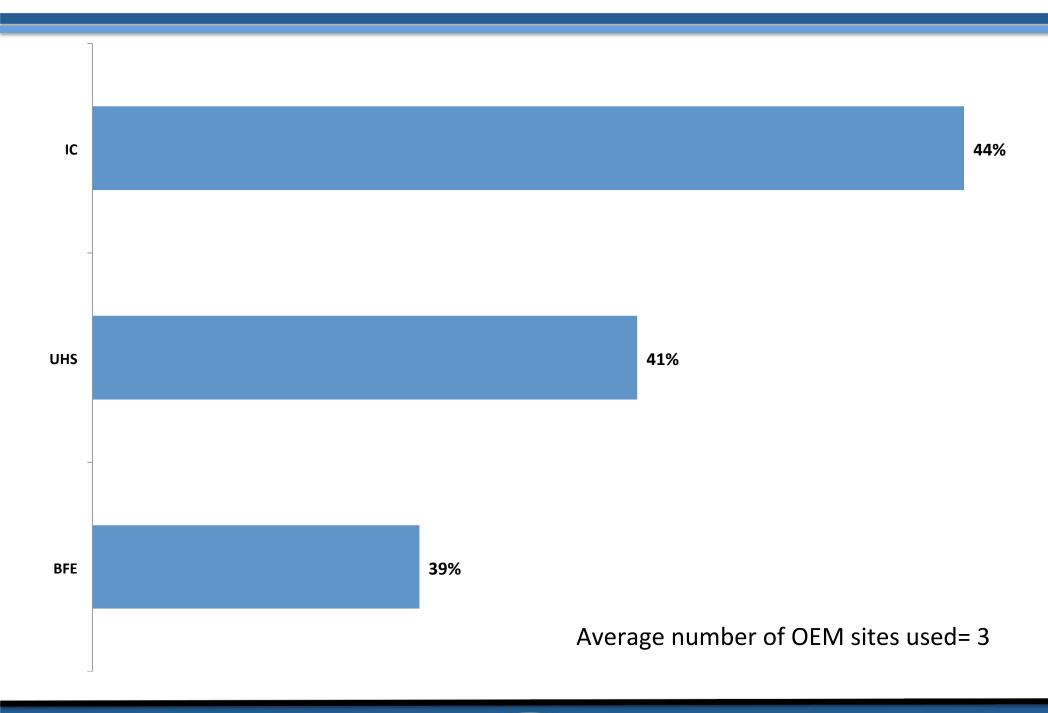


Average percentage of the time spent to perform a full inspection to identify potential maintenance/repair items



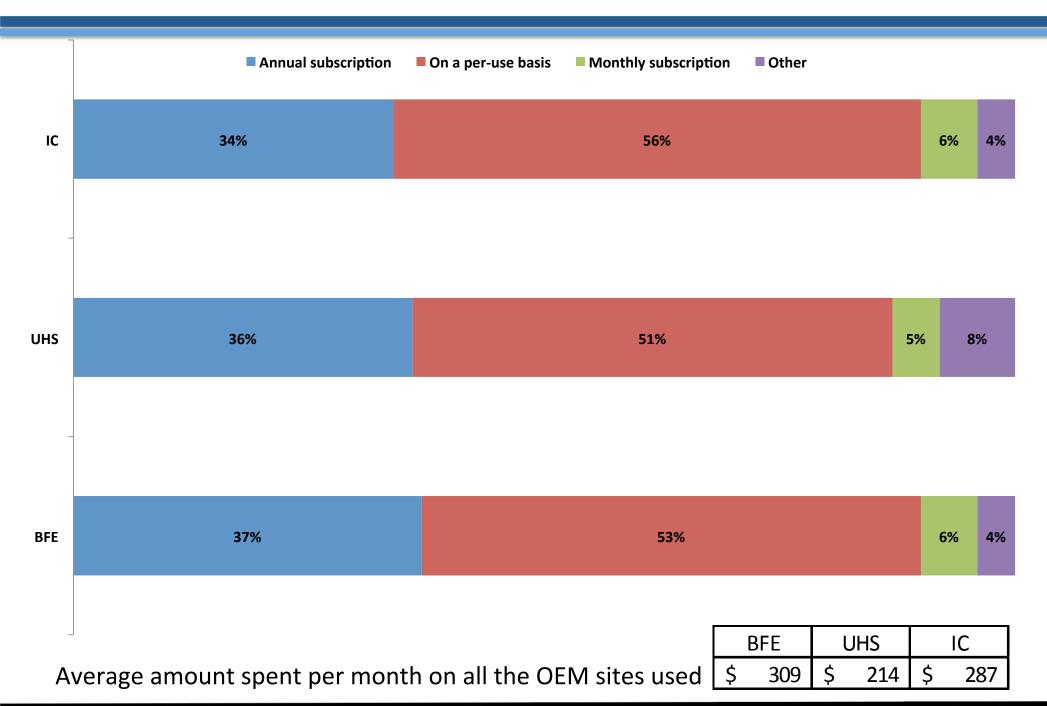


### Percentage who purchase/subscribe to OEM based websites for repair information

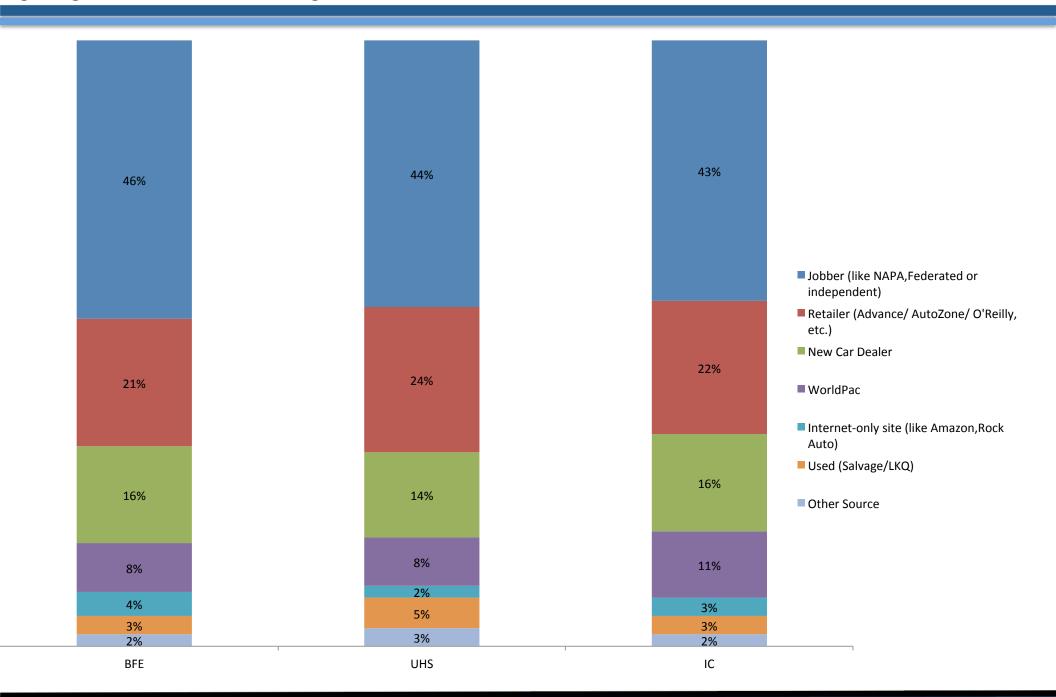




#### If you are using OEM service websites, how do you purchase the information?

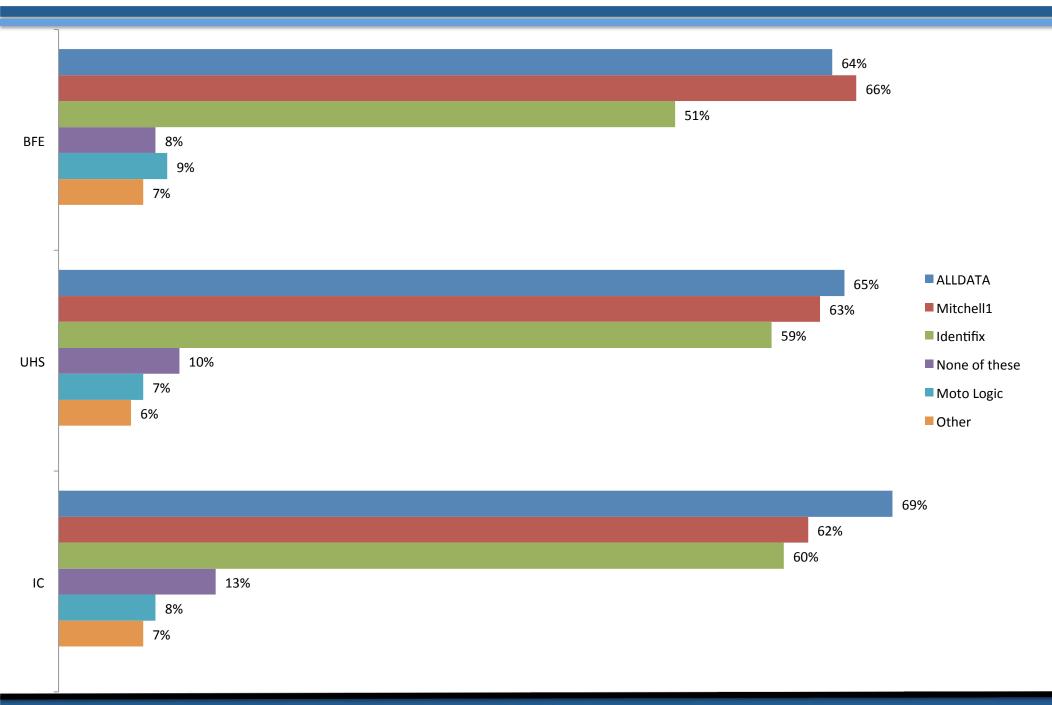


Please think about all the replacement parts you order in a given month. How much do you estimate you are getting from each of the following sources?

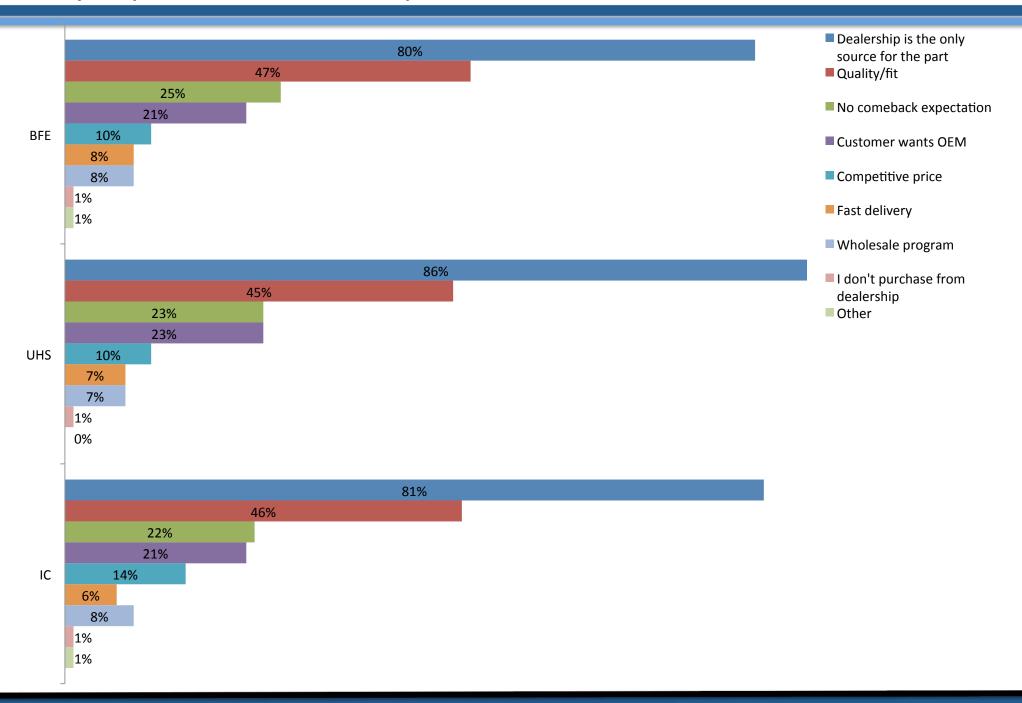




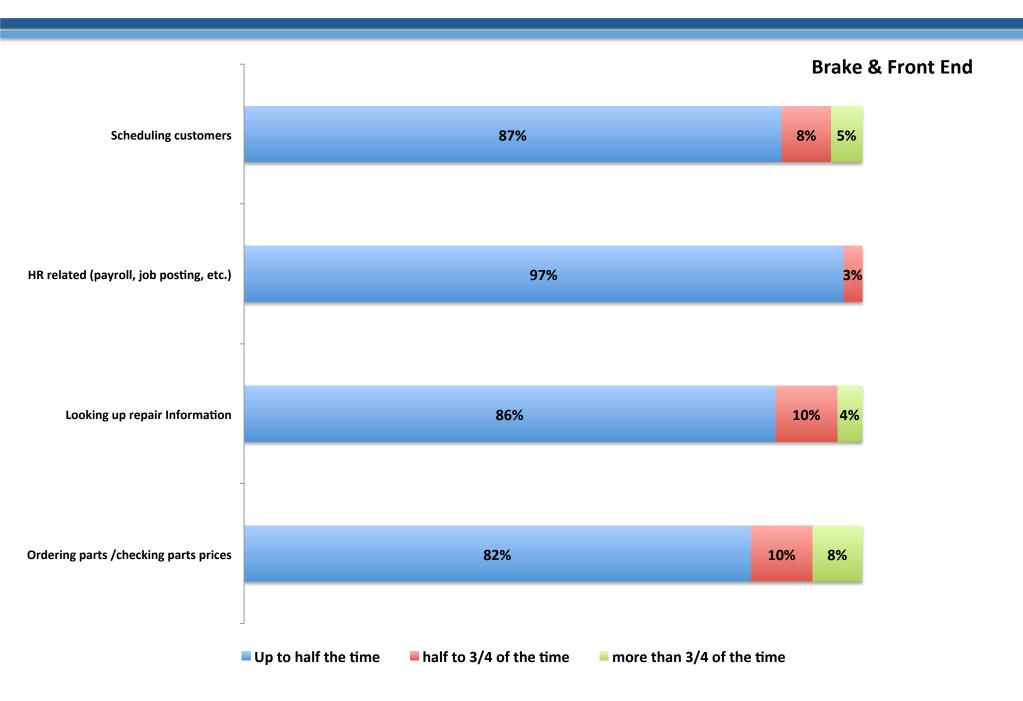

### When you purchase a part from a new car dealership, what factors influence your decision to buy that part instead of an aftermarket part?

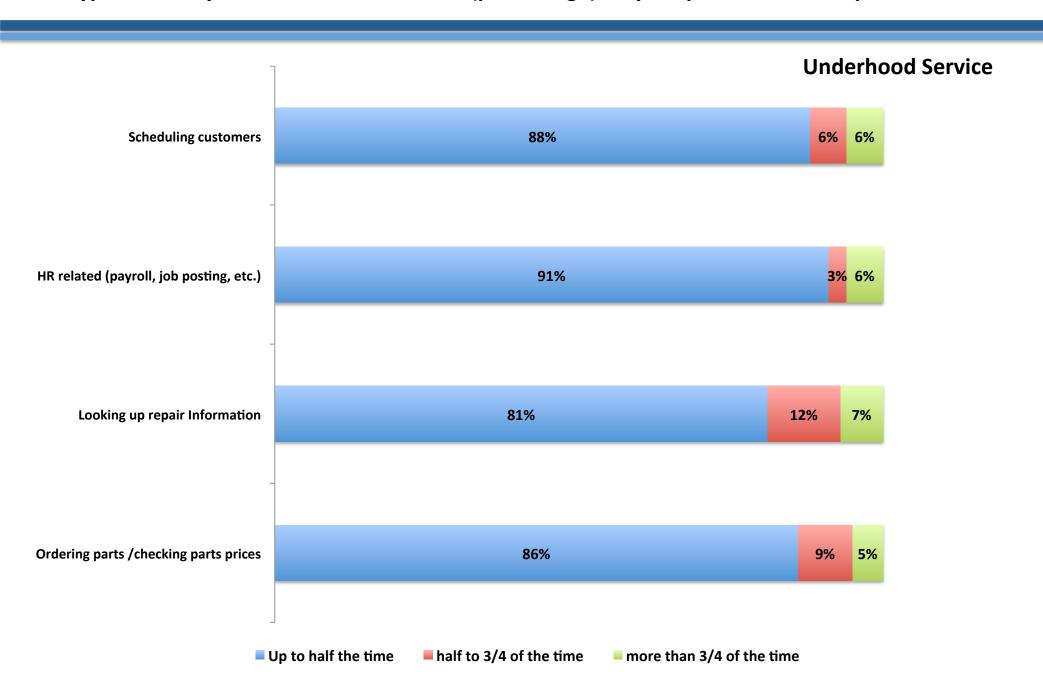


#### In a typical full day at work, how much time (percentage) do you spend on the computer:



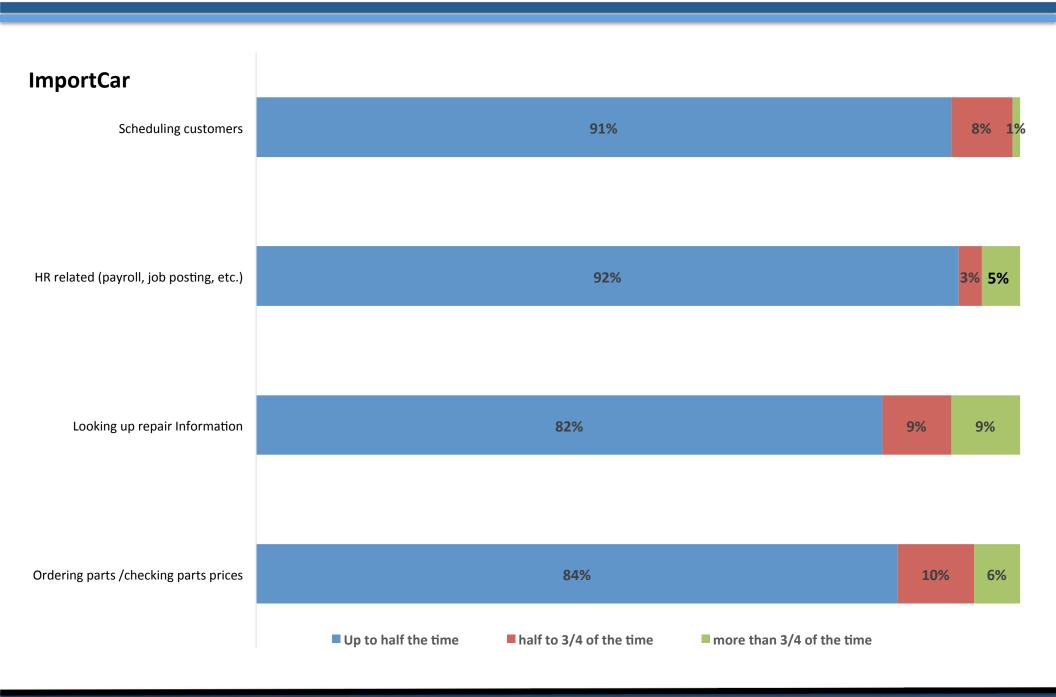

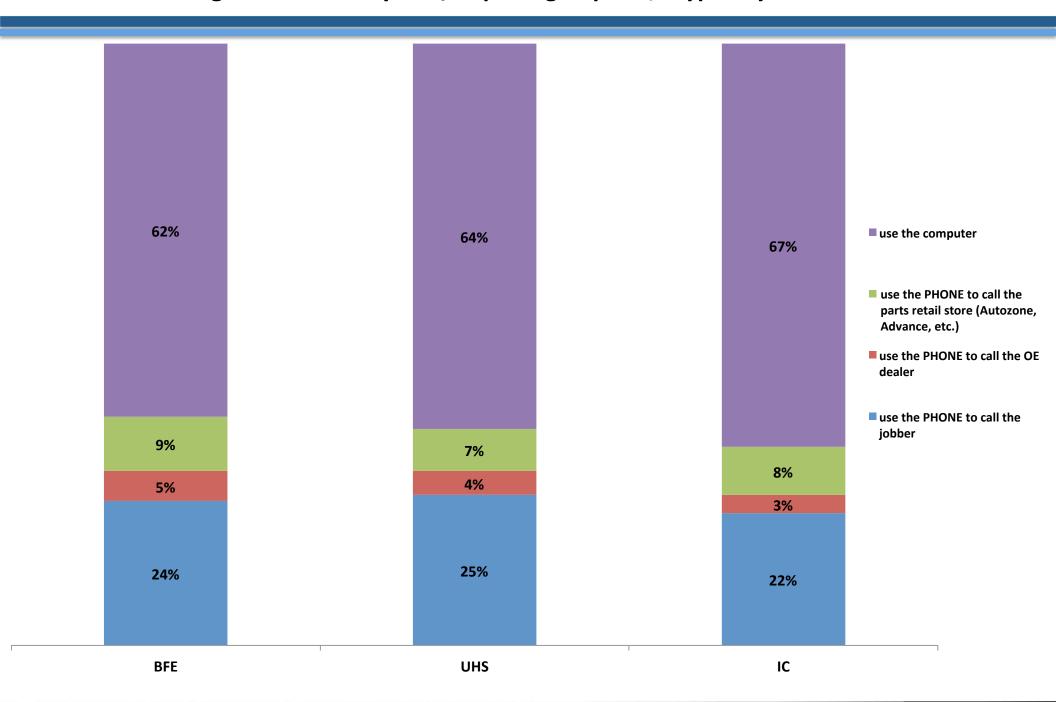

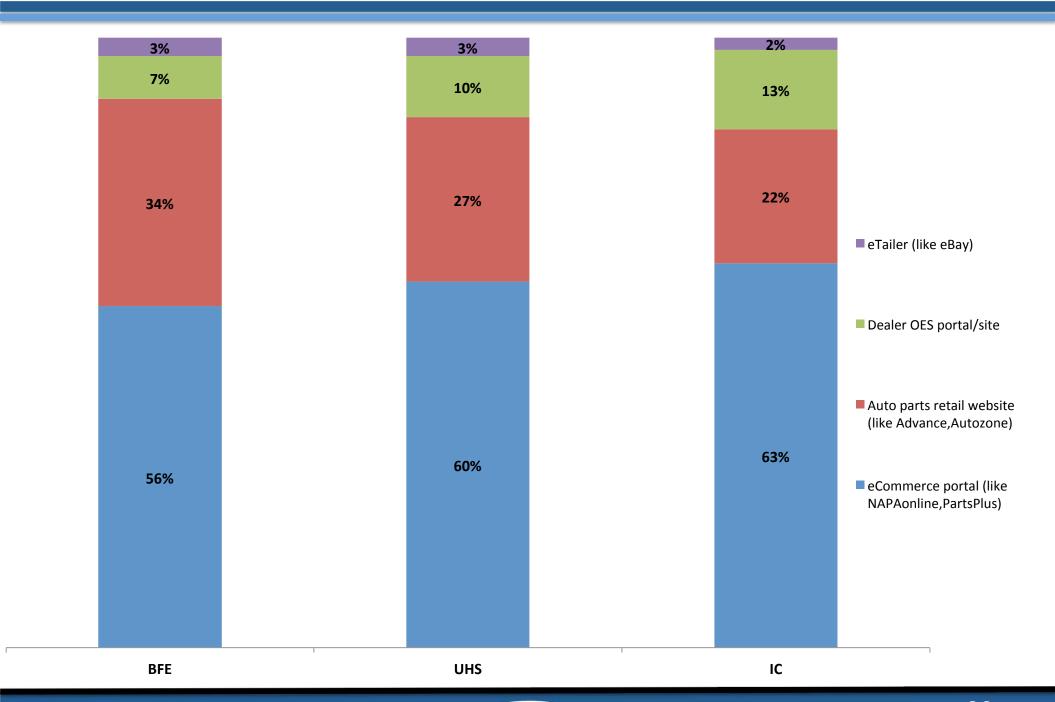


### When checking the availability and/or pricing of parts, I typically:



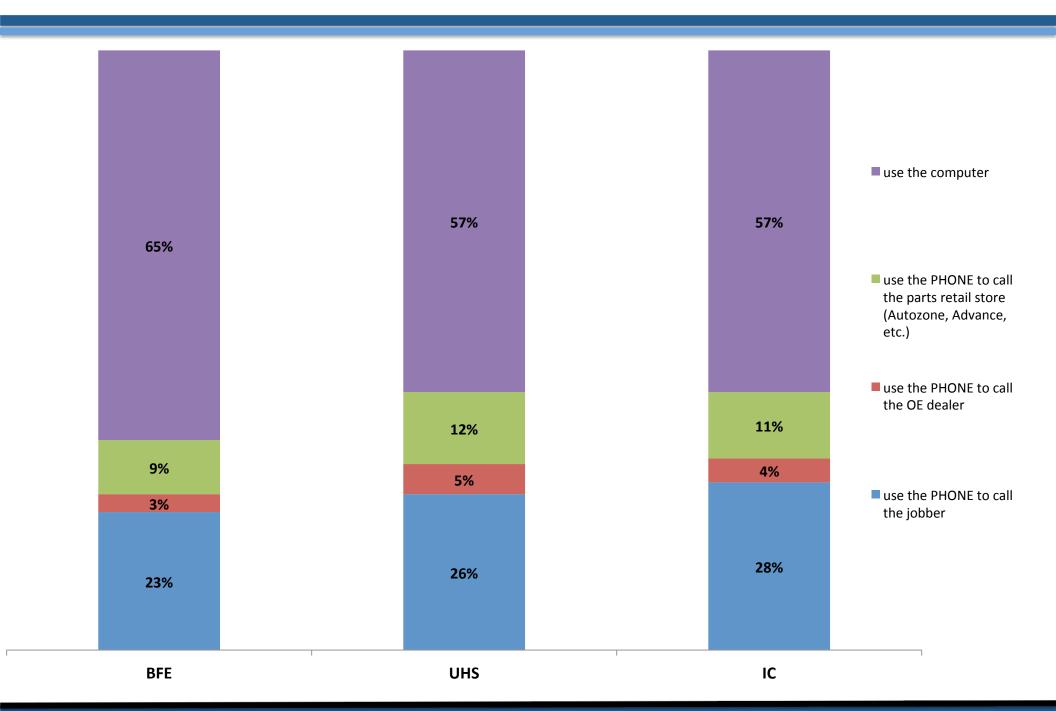


When you check the availability and/or pricing of parts using the computer, about what percentage of the time do you usually go to?



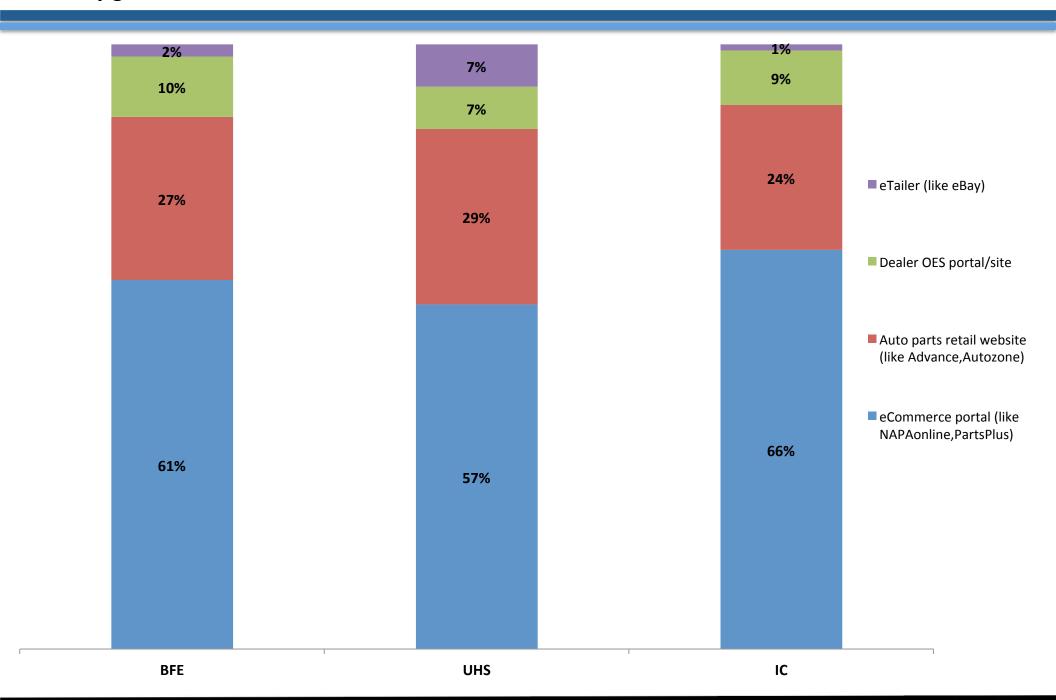

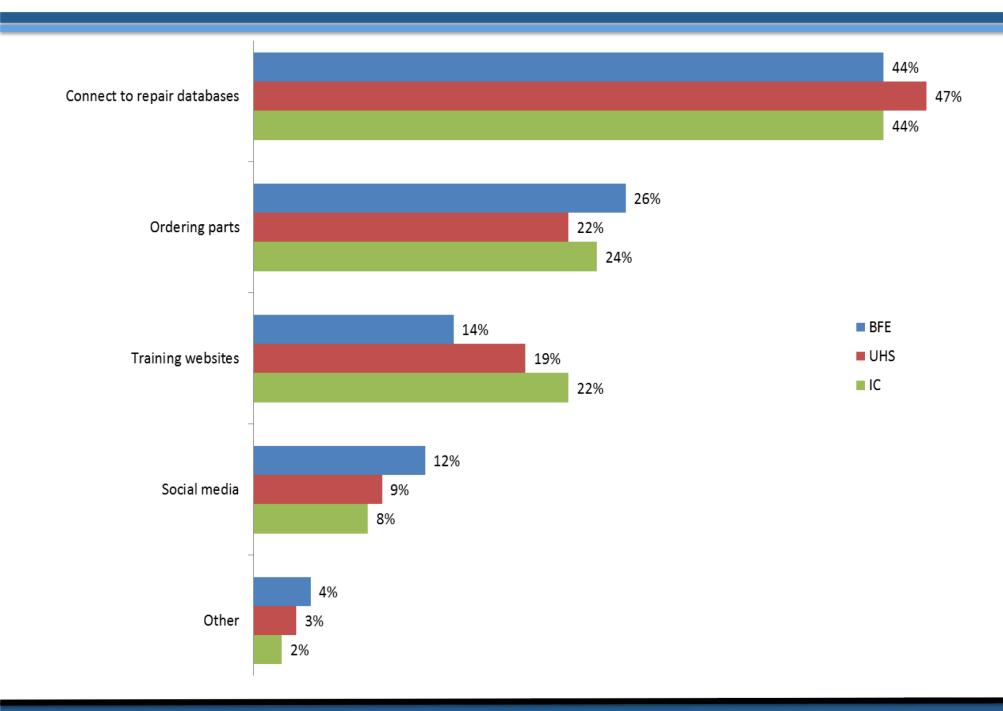








## The most common ways technicians are using the internet access in the service bays





The following section deals with types of replacement parts available in several levels of quality and price according to the age of the vehicle serviced.

How does your sourcing of parts differ when purchasing parts for a vehicle under 7 years old versus vehicles older than 7 years old?

Here are some definitions:

<u>National Brands:</u> Parts that are available throughout the country at various retail, jobber and WD locations (Fel-Pro, Wix, ACDelco).

<u>Store Brands:</u> Parts which are exclusive to a parts retailer or jobber chain (Duralast, Wearever, Parts Master).

<u>OE Supplier:</u> Parts that are from manufacturers who supply parts to OEM's and the aftermarket: (Bosch, Denso, Aisin)

<u>Dealer OE:</u> Parts that are available only through new car dealers (GM, Ford, Toyota).
